2018 License Renewals

- Educators who hold a PEL and ELS-CTE license, with an expiration of 6/30/2018, **may renew beginning April 1, 2018.**
- Educators who hold an ELS-PARA license, with an expiration of 6/30/2018, **may renew beginning April 15, 2018**.
- Educators who hold a SUB license, with an expiration of 6/30/2018, may renew beginning May 1, 2018.

The "renewal" hot link in educators' action centers will not be activated until the dates identified above.

Keep in mind that professional development for this renewal cycle must be completed by June 30, 2018 and PELs and ELS-CTEs must be renewed by August 31, 2018 to prevent them from lapsing.

Tech company gives \$29 million to Donorschoose.org projects

Ripple, a cryptocurrency startup company based in San. Francisco, is spending \$29 million to fund every classroom request on donorschoose.org.

There are currently more than 35,600 classroom requests made on the nonprofit crowdfunding platform. The announcement was made Tuesday night on "The Late Show," hosted by Stephen Colbert.

The gift represents the largest donation received by DonorsChoose.org in its 18-year history, and likely represents the largest ever donation of a digital asset to a single charity. Ripple and its executives contributed the donation in XRP, which was converted to U.S. dollars and used to purchase the classroom materials.

"At Ripple, we care about giving back to our community and we collectively value the importance of quality education in developing the next generation of leaders," said Monica Long, SVP of Marketing at Ripple.



IMPORTANT MESSAGE Regarding Professional Development

Effective This Year (June 30, 2018) and beyond...

If you do not have ALL your PD in by June 30 of the year you renew:

- Your license will lapse
- You will owe \$500 to get it back
- You will still owe the remainder of your PD requirement in order to renew
- You cannot work until
 - 1) the \$500 is paid
 - 2) your PD is entered and hourly requirement met
 - 3) you renew and pay to register

If you recall, it used to be Sept 1 (or actually the first day of school) or sooner if you were teaching summer school in July/Aug. They have emphasized this to us today that this will be how the ELIS system will operate.

Bottom Line according to ISBE: Don't test the system. Complete and enter all of your PD into your ELIS account, and renew and register your license before June 30 of your renewal year.



Free Residential Camp for Girls

Dear Illinois school teachers and counselors: My name is Dr. Kathryn Seigfried-Spellar, and I am an assistant professor at Purdue University in the Department of Computer and Information Technology (CIT).

My Co-PI, Dr. Dawn Laux, and I were awarded a \$100,000 GenCyber grant, funded by the NSA and NSF, to host a free, residential cybersecurity camp at Purdue University for 40 girls, incoming 9th-12th grade. The Purdue Cybersecurity camp is dedicated to increasing awareness and interest in cybersecurity careers as well as increasing diversity within the cybersecurity field. Some of the topics we cover include: digital forensics, the cybercriminal, robotics, and cryptography/ steganography. The residential camp will be held Sunday, June 17th to Friday, June 22nd, 2018 at Purdue University.

We are specifically recruiting students from Indiana and its surrounding states. We believe a residential camp is the only way some students in the Midwest, who may also be economically disadvantaged, will have access to this opportunity. The Midwest is made up of many rural, farming communities, and it may be difficult for these smaller communities to participate in day-camps (e.g., mileage/distance, no public transportation, parents working full-time).

We hope that you can help us reach schools and teachers across the State of Illinois, so we can spread the word about this opportunity to interested students. Maybe we can create the next "generation of cyber stars" (GenCyber) from the Midwest.
