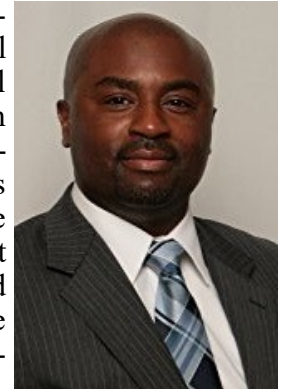

Implementing Acceleration Placement Program Toolkit

Administrators' Academy #1926



The Accelerated Placement Act (Public Act 100-0421) took effect July 1, 2018

The focus of this academy is for principals and assistant principals to understand the requirements of the Accelerated Placement Act and the Accelerated Placement Policy of their district.

Participants will be able to:

- Understand acceleration and supportive research
- Develop a referral process
- Implement a fair, equitable evaluation process
- Develop a transition and support plan for students
- Collect required acceleration data for Illinois School Report Card

The academy is a 5 hour face-to-face and requires one hour to develop a complete acceleration plan that aligns with the district policy.

About the Presenters

Susan Rhodes and Monchelle Krossbaum both serve on the 1926 Gifted Advisory Council and assisted in the development and training of the gifted education seminar. Susan served as the Springfield District gifted coordinator, was instrumental in opening a public gifted magnet school in 2000, served as building principal for nine years, and attached International Baccalaureate Programme authorization for her school. Susan continues to be active within the Illinois Association for Gifted Children and is the current past president. Monchelle is a former Regional Superintendent of Schools, earned her Gifted Education Endorsement, served as a gifted coordinator and taught 4th grade for 20 years. She is the co-founder of the Litchfield Summer Gifted Academy, which is now in its 17th year.
